### **Another successful BID in London**

Leytonstone town centre became the 46<sup>th</sup> BID in the country and the 17<sup>th</sup> in a row in London today, with a 42.5% turnout. 95% of business voted in favour of the BID, representing 91% of the ratable value. The E11 BID, as it will be known, has six themes that incorporate a number of environmentally friendly projects, improvements to the streetscape and local environment, accessibility and car parking, improving the safety and cleanliness of the area and local business community empowerment. #### **Impact of BIDs - Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July; Location: central London**

A seminar to launch the new Annual Evaluation and British BIDs Accreditation systems, as well as presenting examples of BID performance and impact measurement, with speakers from the British Retail Consortium, the Inter Bank Rating Forum and a range of BID case studies. The Annual Evaluation is a questionnaire-based method of knowledge sharing with levy payers based on agreed and standardized measures. The Accreditation System is an industry standard to measure a BID's quality management systems and to assist in ensuring they are on track for a successful renewal ballot.
